23rd Annual Conference

at Bangor University, Bangor, Gwynedd, LL57 2DG**

Our conference provides a forum for anyone interested in women's history in Wales, whether academic or not, to present their work and receive feedback in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere. It is also an opportunity for members and other attendees to network and socialise.

Papers are invited from professional and amateur historians, archivists, and others interested in any aspect of the history of women in Wales for inclusion in the conference programme. Proposals from new researchers and students will be especially welcome [please note too that we offer the Avril Rolph Bursary of £200 for one such submitted paper – see other attachment].

As WAW is involved in the 'Setting the Record Straight: capturing female voices and records in Welsh politics' project this year, papers on the contribution women have made to national / local politics would be especially welcome. Details of the project are on our website (see below)

We welcome both English and Welsh language papers.

Papers will probably be in the region of 30 minutes. Contributors should send an abstract of approximately 150-200 words outlining the key themes to be covered and a short 100 word biography.

Submissions should be made by Friday 15th May 2020.
